11. Make sb do s.th:\v to cause sb to do s.th

E.g.1. She always **makes** me **laugh**.

E.g.2. Don't (Do not) make me cry.

E.g.3. This dress makes me look fat.

E.g.4. Nothing will **make** me **change** my mind.

E.g.5. You can't (cannot) **make** me **change** my mind.

E.g.6. They **made** me **memorize** the whole story.
